Year 1 Newsletter

Welcome to the Spring Term in Year 1.

This term we will be learning all about:

Numeracy

We will be learning addition and subtraction, including adding and subtracting money. We will be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and will learn the difference in orientation and position of these shapes. We will be expanding our knowledge of 2,5 and 10 times tables and looking at sharing into these amounts. We will also be comparing weights of objects using a balance then weighing using scales. Finally we will look at time., including the days of the week.

Literacy

We will be studying fiction, poetry, and non-fiction texts. Key aspects of this term will be extending the children's writing, adjectives, verbs and more difficult punctuation.

RML will be taught on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Each Wednesday your child may bring home an RML book to share with you. Please return these books on the following Monday.

Computing

We will be using the Ipads to video ourselves explaining a recipe, we will also be using drawing programmes to illustrate a story then use audio equipment to the story.

Science

Our first science topic is 'plants'. During this topic we will be looking at different types of plants and trees and exploring the parts of each.


We will create a herbarium as a class and use our knowledge to create a plant identification kit.

'Our second topic is 'Materials'. During this topic we will be comparing materials, exploring soft materials, sorting materials, exploring slime, seeing which object float and sink and which are transparent

RE

In RE we will be learning about saying thank you for the Earth. We will look at different stories of creation and think about how the creator of the world would feel today. We will look at how Christians say thank you to the Earth and understand why the Lords prayer is important to them. Cornerstones

Our topics this term are Paws, Claws and Whiskers and Splendid Skies. We are looking at the habitats and eating habits of different animals and the responsibilities that come with looking after an animal. We will also look at weather patterns, aerial images, cloud structure, wind speed, artists and art work linked to this topic.



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### Music


We are very lucky to have an expert music teacher this year who will be teaching the children how to play the keyboard and various other instruments.

### PE

In PE we will be improving our gymnastic skills. We will use our bodies and simple apparatus to make shapes and move in a variety of ways. We will create sequences of movement and work with partners to improve our skills.

We are going to be learning how to say different colours in French!



### Important information for Year 1

#### Reading

Please continue to help your child to read their reading books at home. When they have completed each book please sign the reading record and return it to school. Your child should have their reading book in school every day.

#### Homework

Spellings will still be tested on a Wednesday each week and new spellings will be sent out on a Friday.

Both homework books need to be in by Wednesday and they too will be sent out on Friday. Please encourage the children to complete only one unit in the red book per week.

#### PE

PE takes place on Mondays and Thursdays. The children should have a full PE kit in school. They should not wear any jewellery and earrings must be removed before they come to school.
