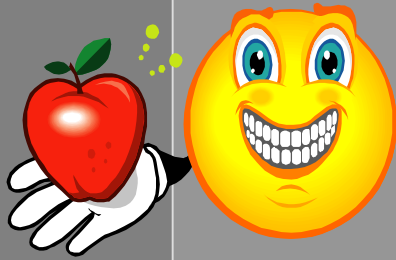


Summer Term 2017

Welcome to the Summer Term in Year 4.
This term we will be learning all about:

Numeracy—In Numeracy this term we will be covering several different topics, including; number and place value, addition and subtraction, properties of shape, multiplication and division, length, area and perimeter, statistics and mass.

Literacy—In Literacy this term we will reading, investigating and writing a variety of different text types, including; poetry, non-chronological reports, narrative writing and creating video guides.

Cornerstones—Our Cornerstones topic this term is '1066' in this topic we will learn about the battle of Hastings, the Bayeux tapestry, the lives of Norman people as well as creating a 3D castle.

Science—Our first Science topic will be 'Grouping Living things' where we will investigate food chains, habitats and life cycles of different living things. Our second topic will be 'Dangers to Living Things in which we will learn how changes to the environment affect where people and animals live.

RE—In RE this term we will be learning about how religious stories teach people to be caring to the world around them.

Music—We will be continuing to have Mr Bough for our 'Rock it' music this term. We will also be learning about different rhythmic patterns in class.

MFL— In French this term we will finish our topic on 'Vive le sport' and then move onto 'Raconte-moi une histoire' looking at simple story telling.
