



Watling Street Primary School - It's great to be gold

At Watling Street we expect all children to behave well, and to treat each other with respect. To support this we have a colour-coded behaviour plan and reward system.

All children start each day on green, this gives every child a positive start to the day. The children can then move up to silver for very good behaviour and attitude. Children then move up to gold for exceptional behaviour and attitude.

Any pupil who achieves 5 gold awards earns a certificate and a Prize from Mrs Powell .

The colour coded system also allows for us to record any incidents of poor behaviour.

Children move down from green to amber. Children are told the reasons why and what they need to do to get back to green. Children who are on amber spend a short time (usually about 5 minutes) with another teacher to think about their choices.

If a pupil's behaviour deteriorates further or they hurt another pupil they are moved down to red. Any pupil who is on this colour band is seen by Mrs. Powell and parents are informed.

All children have a new start the next day and return to green.
